Course Registration Deadline

Effective Feb. 1, 2010 the S.C. Fire Academy will adhere to a mandatory 30-day registration deadline for all Fire Academy courses with a start date of Feb. 1 or later.

Changes for Instructor Courses

Beginning January 1, 2010 the following procedures will be in place for instructor-related programs:

1) Instructor Orientation Workshops (IOWs)

All Instructor Orientation Workshops (IOWs) will be listed in the catalog. During the standard catalog submission process, regional offices will request or solicit these courses as with any course during this process. As with any catalog course, it will be the responsibility of the regional office to set-up the IOW. Example: instructor, equipment, requesting materials for prospective instructor.

With all IOWs being published in the catalog, only special circumstances will allow any request IOW to be held, and this must have approval from the Instructor Services coordinator, assistant superintendent and the superintendent.

2) Student registrations for IOW, Instructor Orientation program (4174) and Lead Evaluator course (4175):

All SCFA student registration forms will be submitted by the region to the Instructor Services office for approval to any IOW, Instructor Orientation program or Lead Evaluator course by the regional office. The approval criteria will include, but is not limited to, the following:

- a) required paperwork for the course
- b) completed apprenticeship for program
- c) experience requirements for any program
- d) instructor teaching history
- e) any program needing management approval

Once approval is obtained, the Instructor Services office will forward the SCFA student registration form to the registrar for registration into the catalog course. Any SCFA student registration form not approved or that does not have the required paperwork or prerequisite will be returned to the applicant for resubmission. The student will still follow the established and published IOW Course Test Procedures for submitting a SCFA registration form.

No SCFA student registration will be accepted after the 30-day cut-off.

Preparing for a Practical Certification Exam

Practical certification exams are conducted at the conclusion of certain courses. The Firefighter I Practical Certification Exam is conducted at the conclusion of course *1153 - NFPA Firefighter I*. The Firefighter II Practical Certification Exam is conducted at the conclusion of course *1154 - NFPA Firefighter II*; the 1002 - Driver/Operator-Pumper practical exams are given at the conclusion of courses *1220 - Pump Operations I*, *1221 - Pump Operations II* and course *1210 - Emergency Vehicle Driver Training*; the practical exam for Instructor I is conducted at the end of course *4171 - Fire Instructor I*.

Based on this evaluation method, these courses are prerequisites to completing the written certification examination. Students who are successful in the course should be well prepared to take the practical skills exam. However, since the practical skills examinations contain several objectives, which they may be asked to perform, students should be prepared to perform all of the manipulative or practical objectives listed in the NFPA standard for that certification level. All practical skills tests are graded on a pass/fail system with a passing score required for successful completion of the certification exam. Passing means that the student performed the skill correctly, while failing means that the student performed the skill unsafely or to the point of being ineffective. Each student will be given two attempts to perform each required skill during the same test session. Should the student not receive a pass rating on the initial attempt, he/she will be eligible for an immediate second attempt. Students will be retested only on the skill that was not performed satisfactorily after two attempts. One retest opportunity is allowed for students failing to meet the minimum score for a practical skills exam. Any student failing to complete the second attempt will be required to retest the failed skill at a later date. The student must wait at least 30 days before retesting. Failing the retest means that the student must retake the training program before being eligible for retesting again.

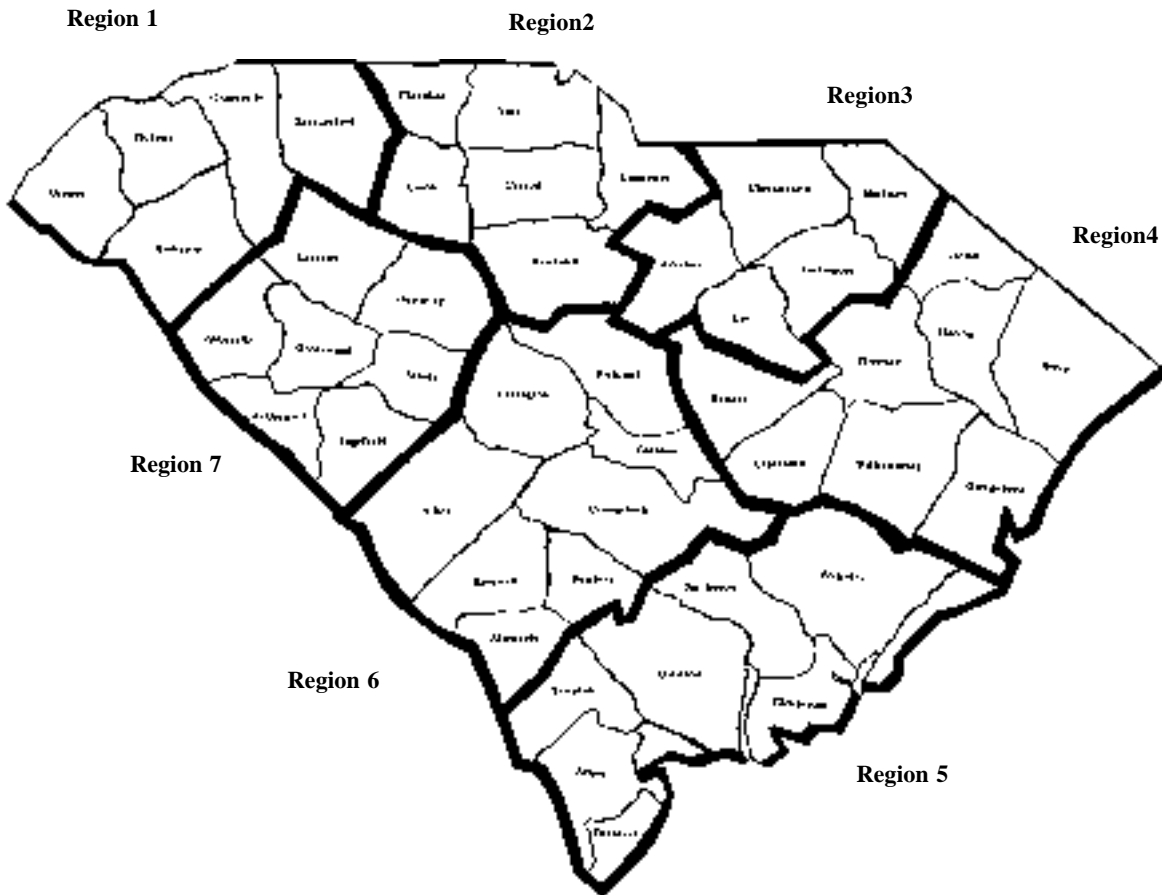
